

What Are the Reasons and Prognosis of Patients With Sarcoidosis Hospitalized in Emergency?

STUDY DESIGN

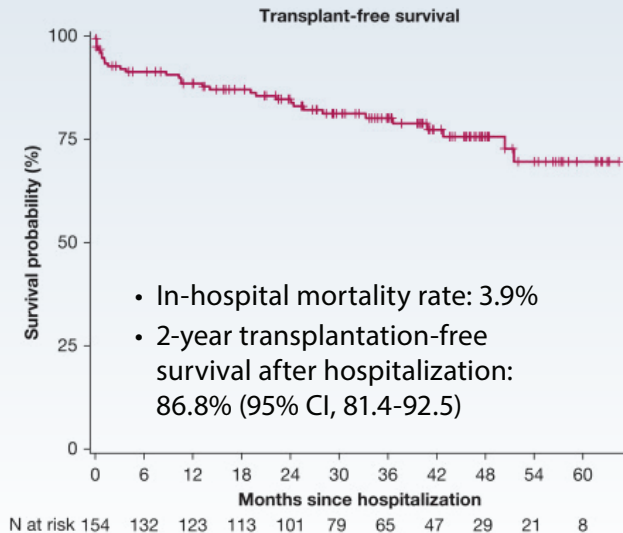
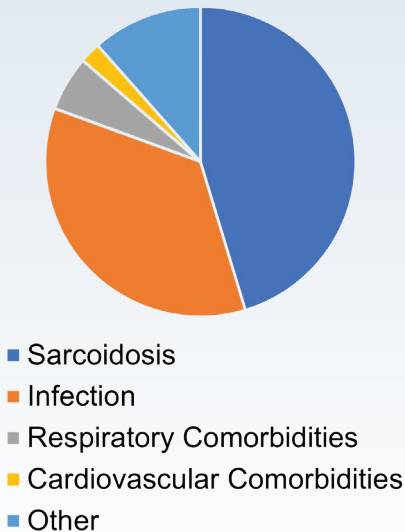
Retrospective monocentric study of **154 patients** with sarcoidosis:

- **14 (9%)** required the ICU
- **20 (14%)** with incident case of sarcoidosis

Primary reason for hospitalization:

- **32 (21%)** with lower respiratory infection (most common)
- **17 (11%)** with acute pulmonary exacerbation of sarcoidosis

RESULTS



In this study, the overall mortality of patients with sarcoidosis hospitalized in emergency was high, with lower respiratory infection as the most common cause of hospitalization.
